
Installing 4600R Scanners


Step 1. Remove all drivers associated with the Honeywell or HHP scanners by going into the Device Manager, opening the control panel and then going to System / Device Manager.

Go to Ports (Com & LPT). If there are any devices listed under it associated with the 4600R, right-click on them and uninstall them. Check the box to delete the software for the device. Do the same with the USB (Universal Serial Bus controllers).



- 2. Unplug the scanner
- 3. Create a directory called Scanner. If one exists delete it and recreate it.
- 4. Download and store the HSM USB Serial Driver... zip file available on the VISTA home page under "Scanner Model 4600R Executable" in the Scanner directory that you just created. Right-click on the file to extract it.

5. Go to the folder where you've extracted the files. Select the Install_x64 for 64 bit systems or the install_x86 for 32 bit systems and double click on it. It will ask several times for permission to install items on your machine. Select "yes" each time.



- 6. Plug in scanner.
- 7. Go back to the device manager screen and select Action / Scan for Hardware Changes. This menu is found at the top of the screen/window.
- 8. After a few seconds it should find your scanner and install the driver. It should now have an item under Ports called IT4600 Area Imager.
- 9. Right click on the Imager item and select properties. Select the Port Settings tab. You should have the following settings:

Bits per second: 19200

Data bits: 8
Parity: None
Stop bits: 1

Flow control: None

- 10. Press the advanced button. Select COM9 for the COM Port Number and press OK.
- 11. This should set up your scanner. You will need to exit Vista and restart it since it looks to see if you have a scanner when you log in.
